

Vatican hosts youth symposium against human trafficking

(Vatican Radio) Young men and women involved in the fight against human trafficking will be making their voices heard in the Vatican this weekend at a youth symposium on the best ways of preventing and supporting victims of this widespread phenomenon. The two day meeting has been jointly organised by the Pontifical Academy of Sciences, the interfaith Global Freedom Network and the Argentinian anti-trafficking association 'Vinculos En Red'. Speakers, including young survivors of trafficking and sexual exploitation will be sharing experiences and hoping to draw up some practical ideas for combatting this global trade that affects around 21 million men, women and children in all corners of the globe.
